Public Involvement Plan

Citizens play an essential role in the development of transportation plans by helping identify community goals and objectives, establishing a common vision, identifying transportation problems and potential solutions, and helping decision-makers set priorities.

The Process

Following is the process discussed and approved by RTC.

1. At the beginning RLRP development, the local RTC member and Residency Administration will introduce the program to City Council and the Board of Supervisors. The progress of RLRP will be reported on a quarterly basis.
2. The public will be notified on the progress of RLRP by:
 - sending press release to the media
 - using Web site notices
 - inviting citizens to view the technical or policy information
3. Before the Plan adoption, public meetings will be held at two locations, and not more than three places.
4. The RLRP is a regional plan and the progress of plan development will be reported to Crater Planning District Commission on a regular basis. The final RLRP will be considered and adopted by the Commission.
5. After the Plan adoption, the local governing bodies will be briefed and asked for their support of RLRP.

Regardless of the format or the process, public input is always welcomed. At the meeting, information will be provided to participants and comments can be made without attending the meeting. Written, e-mail, and telephone comments are welcomed also.

After public involvement activities, CPDC will develop a draft RLRP. Copies of the draft documents are available for public review and comment at local jurisdictions and at the Crater PDC office. After considering the feedback from the review period, Crater PDC will develop a final RLRP document.
