MAIN POINTS

- Prioritization for SYIP transportation projects
- Improved transparency and accountability
- Maximum benefits for tax dollars spent
- Objective scoring formula
- CTB not required to allocate funds to highest scoring projects



FACTORS

- Congestion Mitigation
- Safety
- Accessibility
- Environmental Impact
- Economic Development
- Land Use
- Cost*



HB2 2015-2016

- First applications submitted September 2015
- 34 projects ineligible
- 287 projects scored
- Project scores released January 2016
- Consideration for SYIP inclusion underway
- 5 of top 20 highest scoring projects in rural areas



ELEVATING FACTORS

- Low Cost*
- Safety
- Intermodal Connection
- Low Environmental Impact



PREPARING APPLICATION

- Not necessary to hire consultant
- "Polished" document not required
- VDOT will assist with cost estimates and construction details if time permits
- September 30 application deadline
- Support resolutions due December 1



FINAL THOUGHTS

- Project should be in Comprehensive Plan, Rural Transportation Plan, or other official document
- Local \$ match not required, although including local \$ can help score
- Begin work now to submit by September 30
- Crater PDC can assist
